SWACDA to Host Research Poster Session

Call for Papers

SWACDA will sponsor a research poster session at its convention in Denver in February 2010. We are accepting submissions of completed studies and papers representing historical, descriptive, experimental and philosophical approaches. These may be either quantitative or qualitative in design. Deadline for submissions is: September 10, 2009.

Submission procedures: All submissions should not have been published prior to the convention, and must meet the Code of Ethics published regularly in the Journal of Research in Music Education (also available at www.menc.org). Electronic submissions are encouraged (in MS Word). Abstracts and complete papers should be emailed to Dr. Charles Robinson, Research Poster Session Coordinator, at robinsonc@umkc.edu. For those unable to send electronic copies, four copies of the report and abstract may be mailed to: Dr. Charles Robinson; SWACDA Research Poster Session; Conservatory of Music and Dance; University of Missouri-Kansas City; 4949 Cherry Street; Kansas City, MO 64110. Submissions will be considered by the review committee as they are received.

Notification procedures: Notifications will be mailed or emailed within 3 weeks of receipt, and no later than November 15, 2009. If accepted, the primary of a listed co-researcher must register for and attend the SWACDA convention to present the poster. Accepted presenters will also be expected to bring 40 copies of their abstract and 10 copies of the complete paper to the research poster session. The paper should be summarized and shown in poster format of approximately 30" x 40", and will be discussed informally with convention participants as they peruse the poster session. Traditionally, this provides for a positive and engaging discourse along with multiple opportunities to meet professionals of diverse and of similar interests.
