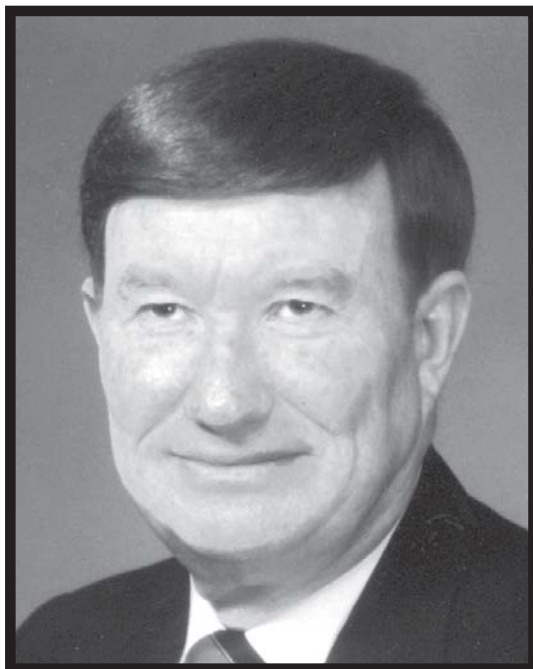

Judy Bowers is Professor of choral music education at Florida State University, where she teaches undergraduate and graduate courses in choral music and music education. She also conducts the Women's Glee Club. Her research interests include leading community service partnerships, developmental choral groups, the adolescent voice change, and at-risk music students. Bowers hold a PhD from Louisiana State University. From 1999-2000 she led the Capital Children's Choir Program in FSU and more recently, has developed a community service partnership with a downtown middle school. Since 2000, this collaboration has provided additional music ensembles for middle school students (a jazz band, steel drum ensembles, and a music choir).



Judy R. Arthur, Accompanist

Judy R. Arthur holds degrees from Florida State University College of Music and is the Director of Choral Activities at Leon High School in Tallahassee, Florida. Leon High is one of the oldest public schools in Florida and currently offers forty performing arts classes. Dr. Arthur has accompanied and conducted numerous honor choirs in Florida and was the accompanist for the junior high honor choir at the 2006 Southern Division Conference. She has served as Florida's High School Repertoire & Standards Chair and has served as the president of the Florida ACDA. Dr. Arthur is currently the treasurer for Florida ACDA.

Tim Sharp, Conductor

Tim Sharp is Executive Director of the American Choral Directors Association. An active choral conductor as well as writer, Sharp came to ACDA from Rhodes College, Memphis, TN, where he conducted the Rhodes Singers and MasterSingers Chorale. Before his appointment at Rhodes, he was director of choral activities at Belmont University in Nashville, TN. Sharp's research and writing focuses pedagogically in conducting and score analysis as evidenced by his publications *Precision Conducting*, *Achieving Choral Blend and Balance*, and *Up Front! Becoming the Complete Choral Conductor*. Sharp holds a BMA degree in conducting from the School of Church Music of the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, KY. He is a Clare Hall Life Fellow at Cambridge University, Cambridge, UK, has studied at the Aspen School of Music, and the Harvard NEH Medieval Sacred Music Studies program.



Timothy Marek, Accompanist

Timothy Marek is a graduate of Southern Nazarene University where he received a Bachelor of Arts degree in organ performance and a Bachelor of Science degree in accounting. He received his Master of Music degree in organ performance from the University of Oklahoma. Mr. Marek serves as Associate Organist at All Souls Episcopal Church in Oklahoma City. At Southern Nazarene University, Mr. Marek teaches private organ and piano, and is a staff accompanist for vocal and instrumental recitals and choral programs. He has been accompanist for the Canterbury Choral Society and the Master Chorale of Oklahoma City. He is an active member of the Oklahoma City chapter of the American Guild of Organists, currently holding the office of Dean and serving as coordinator for the 2011 Southwest Regional Convention.

High School Honor Choir

Christine Bass, Conductor

Christine Bass' life-long love of choral music began at the age of four when she joined the Cherub Choir at First Presbyterian Church in Flint Michigan under the direction of William T. Rennecker. Bass earned her bachelors and masters degrees from Westminster where she studied conducting under Simpson, Brown, Megill and Flummerfelt and was a member of the Westminster Choir. She has since received their distinguished Alumni Merit Award and the Alumni Ambassador Award from Westminster. In 1996 she was named New Jersey MENC Master Music Teacher and received the Governor's Award in Arts Education. She has served as guest conductor and clinician presenting workshops for NJEA, NJMEA and ACDA and WCC. She conducted the 1996 All South Jersey and the 2002 New Jersey State Chorus. She has served on the NJACDA Board as the Repertoire & Standards Chair for Male Choirs. Christine has been selected for Who's Who of American Teachers and Who's Who of American Women. Recently the Cherry Hill West program was featured in the Choral Directors Magazine and Christine was named as a "Choral Director of Note." Her top choir, West Singers, performed at the 1999, 2003 and 2005 ACDA National Conventions the 2001 MENC and 2004 ACDA All Eastern Conventions. They have sung under the baton of Allen Gilbert, Julius Rudel, Rossen Milanov, with Philadelphia's Singing City Chorus and the Newark Boys Choir. Her men's a cappella group, Men of Note are three time National Champions.



Casey Cook Westfall, Accompanist

Casey Cook Westfall graduated from Capital University cum laude with a bachelor of music degree in keyboard pedagogy where she accompanied the Chapel Choir. Prior to Capital, she spent two years studying with Dr. Nelita True at the Eastman School of Music. She has accompanied at Capital University, The Ohio State University and Otterbein College. Westfall was invited to serve as pianist and organist for the Chapel Choir, the Otterbein Kinderchor and the Bexley Vocal Ensemble on the choirs' European concert tours. Since 2000, Westfall has served as accompanist for the Columbus Symphony Orchestra chorus. Westfall has also played under the baton of Helmut Rilling, James Paul, Alessandro Sicilliani, Timothy Russell, Albert George Schram, Giancarlo Guerrero, Gunther Herbig, Vladimir Spivakov, Stefan Sanderling and Junichi Hirokami. In addition to her role with the CSO, she also serves as accompanist for The Ohio State University Symphonic Choir and Women's Glee Club, and the Bexley High School Choirs. Westfall is a member of the National Guild of Piano Teachers and the Suzuki Association of the Americas.

Collegiate Honor Chamber Choir

Gary Graden, Conductor

Gary Graden studied at Clark University, the Hartt School of Music, the Aspen Summer Music Festival, and the Royal Academy of Music in Stockholm, under Eric Ericson. Graden is choral director at St. Jacob's Church in Stockholm. He has been on the faculty of Stockholm's Musikgymnasium, where he founded and conducted the Stockholm Musikgymnasiums Chamber Choir. With this choir and the St. Jacobs Chamber Choir, he has won grand prizes and first prizes in several of Europe's most prestigious competitions. He has taught choral conducting, held master classes, and conducted professional choirs around the world. He is the recipient of the "Johannes Norrby Medal" for his contribution to Swedish choral music. He was elected Sweden's 2005 Choral Conductor of the Year.



Joey M. Martin, Accompanist

Joey M. Martin is a musician regarded for his diverse musical interests, engaging artistry, and passionate enthusiasm for the choral art. He is professor of music at Texas State University-San Marcos and serves as the Director of Choral Activities teaching graduate courses in choral conducting, choral literature and vocal pedagogy. During his time at Texas State he has directed four of the six university choirs. Choirs under his direction have appeared at the Southwest Division of ACDA, the International Kodály Festival, and in spring 2009, the Texas Music Educators Association Convention. During the summer of 2005 he traveled with Texas State Chorale giving concerts in Vienna, Budapest, Salzburg, and Prague. In 2007 he returned to Europe with VocaLibre for a week of shared learning at the Slovakian National Conservatory in Bratislava.



In addition to his work at Texas State, he has served as the artistic director for the Alamo City Men's Chorale and is currently music director for historic First Protestant Church (New Braunfels, TX). Dr. Martin recently joined Craig Hella Johnson and Michelle Schumann to form the creative team for the Victoria Bach Festival. Martin also enjoys collaborating with vocal artists in recitals serving as coach/accompanist for such diverse artists are Maria Jette, Timothy Jones, Cheryl Parrish, and Juli Wood. Dr. Martin received his DMA in choral conducting from the University of Texas-Austin where he studied conducting with Craig Hella Johnson, piano with Betty Mallard, and voice with Martha Deatheridge.
